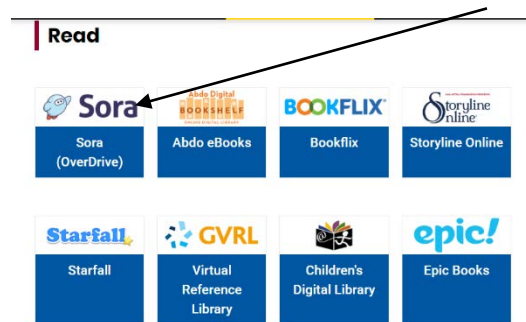
Google Classroom - at home help
