


Signing out Your Child and After School Arrangements




Out-of-Area Students

The Durham District School Board allows for students to attend a school other than the one in their own catchment area, provided there is space, and that permission is granted by the Principal and Area Superintendent.

Application for Out of Area status must be made each year and expires at the end of the current school year. Renewal of status for the 2020/2021 school year is now due and we ask that you submit your application by **March 12**, **2020**. Those families who are here out of area, must reapply yearly as <u>attendance at Coronation is not guaranteed</u>.
